### Delaware COVID-19 School Testing Program

Hello Parents, Students and Staff!

In partnership with the Delaware Department of Health and Quidel, Charter School of New Castle is offering on-site COVID-19 testing. We require everyone to pre-register through Primary Health's platform: [CLICK HERE TO REGISTER](#). This registration will take no longer than 5 minutes and is only done one time!

Here is a little more about the testing program and process:

- Testing is **required** weekly for all in-person students and staff. It is free of cost to you so no insurance information is needed, or will you ever be asked to pay for these tests.
- Testing will primarily be done through self-swabbing and monitored by medical staff on site - school staff will not be doing the testing.
- The test being used for this program is the Quidel QuickVue. For more information on the test, please read the fact sheet here: [Quidel QuickVue Fact Sheet](#).
- Results and communication will be shared electronically to the email and contact information used for registration. Results are primarily shared the day of testing.
- If your child tests positive, the school will contact you directly.
- **Testing will begin the week of September 13, 2021. Registration must be completed by September 8, 2021. Students who are not registered for testing, will not be permitted to enter the school building on Monday, September 13, 2021.**
